Discussion on written guidance regarding CCSD gender diverse students

The Clark County School District is looking for your input on whether we should develop written guidance on how to ensure gender diverse students feel safe and respected in school.

A working group has been meeting for several months and has recommended that CCSD develop both a policy/regulation and administrative guidelines regarding gender diverse students. The group also suggested some topics that written guidelines could include, which are posted at ccsd.net/genderdiverse.

You can also attend one of five public meetings to give your input. Each speaker will be allotted two minutes, and they can also fill out comment cards at the event.

CCSD staff will present the recommendations of the working group, the results of the public input meetings and the results of the [online survey](#) at the Jan. 10, 2018, board work session, where they will seek guidance from Trustees on whether or not to take next steps to develop a written policy/regulation or guidelines.
